Poster Submission and Presentation

- A short abstract of the poster — from 1 to 2 pages in length using the Springer LNCS Proceedings format – must be submitted through the CMT system: <https://cmt.research.microsoft.com/WBDBP2015/>
- The student should either be the sole author or the first author of the poster.
- The posters will be subjected to the same review process as the papers, and the poster selection committee's decision will be final. The corresponding authors of the accepted posters will be informed of the decision directly by email.
- Registration fees will be waived (reimbursed) for students with accepted posters, but the students must be registered in the Workshop.
- An accepted poster must be printed at the student's cost in the specified format, and presented by the student in person at the Workshop venue on the specified date, time and location.
